Throughout this IFB you will see references to GOMA. The name change happened recently so the names are interchangeable.

This is also the first time that the bid form is not incorporated into the IFB. It is a separate attachment, a protected excel spreadsheet. It is labeled as “ATTACHMENT F BID PRICING”. You will input the page pricing and the formula will show (1) Overall Bid Price per Page, (2) Average Page Price and (3) Estimated Contract Value for the 5 year contract.
