NOTICE OF RESCHEDULE OF HEARING

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To: All Parties of Record and Interested Persons

Due to the recent inclement weather, the January 25, 2016 bids for contracts for a portion of the residential and Type I customer loads by the Potomac Edison Company ("PE") and the Type II customer loads for PE, Baltimore Gas and Electric Company ("BGE"), Delmarva Power and Light Company ("DPL") and Potomac Electric Power Company ("Pepco") have been postponed until February 1, 2016. Therefore, the Public Service Commission ("Commission") hereby gives notice of a reschedule of the January 28, 2016 hearing to Thursday, February 4, 2016 at 4:00 p.m., for the Standard Offer Service ("SOS") Bid Monitor consultant and the Commission's Technical Staff to brief the Commission on the conduct of the February 1, 2016 solicitations for offers for quarterly contracts for the Type II SOS loads by PE, BGE, DPL, and Pepco (collectively, the "IOUs") and the results, in conjunction with the hearing for review of PE's residential and Type I SOS procurement results.¹ The IOUs are hereby directed to provide Commission Staff no later than 9 a.m., Wednesday, February 3, 2016, with individual class retail bill impact data consistent with the results of the January 25th bids to ensure that Staff is able to file its written testimony in the matter prior to the hearing commencement time.

The hearing will be held in the Commission's 16th Floor Hearing Room, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. As discussed in Order No. 81102

Provisions of the 2015 Request for Proposals for Full Requirements Wholesale Electric Power Supply issued for the Type II SOS bidding to be conducted in 2015 and 2016, established bid week schedules similar to those established in Order No. 81102, included holding hearings to review the results of the Type II SOS bidding. in Case No. 9064,² the Commission will conduct a review of confidential and highly commercially sensitive bidder specific data during the process and at the hearings. The public briefing, therefore, will include only the information that can be made public under the provisions of the request for proposals and the full requirements service agreement. Additionally, the Commission will solicit remarks from any of the parties and members of the public following the briefing. To the extent necessitated by confidentiality considerations, the Commission will employ *in camera* procedures.
