ORDER DIRECTING STATUS UPDATES ON ENERGY STORAGE PILOT PROJECTS

- 1. On November 26, 2020, the Commission issued Order No. 89664, approving six pilot energy storage projects. On April 21, 2021, the Commission issued Order No. 89805, approving two more pilot energy storage projects. Since then, the Commission has extended the operational deadlines for each of those projects.
- 2. The Commission now directs that the utilities participating in the energy storage pilot file within 30 days of this Order a status report on their approved energy storage projects. That report should state whether the projects are operational or not, the expected date of operation if not, and any concerns that could impact the utility's ability to meet the statutory and Commission timelines of this pilot.
- 3. For any project not operational by the time of that status report, the Commission directs the utility to file an additional status report every 180 days until the project comes fully operational, at which time the utility shall file a notice that the project is completed and operational.
