Notice of Additional Rulemaking Session (RM76)

On February 14, 2024, the Commission issued a Notice of Further Rulemaking Session¹ to adopt proposed changes to COMAR 20.06 as filed by the Leader of the Cybersecurity Reporting Work Group (CSRWG).² After receiving written comments, the Commission held a hearing on March 27, 2024, and the Commission took no action on the proposed regulations. Subsequently, on April 17, 2024, the Cybersecurity Reporting Work Group Leader filed a supplemental report with revised regulation proposals and counterproposals.³

The Commission gives notice that it will conduct an additional rulemaking session on Wednesday, June 5, 2024, to continue consideration of the proposed revisions in the above-captioned proceeding. The rulemaking session will begin 10 minutes after the conclusion of the Commission's Administrative Meeting, which begins at 10:00 a.m., in the Frank O. Heintz Hearing Room, on the 16th Floor of the William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland.
