NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND

On March 6, 2019, Baltimore Gas and Electric Company, Delmarva Power & Light Company, The Potomac Edison Company, Potomac Electric Power Company, Southern Maryland Electric Cooperative, Choptank Electric Cooperative, and Washington Gas Light Company (collectively, "Maryland Utilities") filed with the Maryland Public Service Commission ("Commission") a Motion for Reconsideration ("Motion") in the above-styled proceeding.
