**NOTICE OF HEARING AND
OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT**

On May 31, 2019, the Maryland Department of Human Resources, Family Investment Administration, Office of Home Energy Programs (“OHEP”) filed its Electric Universal Service Program (EUSP) *Proposed Operations Plan for Fiscal Year 2020* (“Proposed Plan”)¹ with the Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”).
