## NOTICE OF HEARING

To: All Parties of Record and Interested Persons

The Maryland Public Service Commission ("Commission") hereby gives notice of hearing on Thursday, October 25, 2018, at 2:00 p.m., for the Standard Offer Service ("SOS") Bid Monitor consultant and the Commission's Technical Staff to brief the Commission on the conduct of the October 22, 2018 solicitations for the residential and/or Type I SOS load procurements by The Potomac Edison Company, Baltimore Gas and Electric Company, Delmarva Power & Light Company, and Potomac Electric Power Company (collectively, the "IOUs") and the results, in conjunction with the hearing for review of the IOU's Type II SOS procurement results. Each IOU is hereby directed to provide Commission Staff, no later than 9 a.m., Wednesday, October 24, 2018, with the retail bill impact data consistent with the results of the October 22, 2018 bids to ensure that Staff is able to file its written testimony in the matter prior to the hearing commencement time.

The hearing will be held in the Frank O. Heintz Hearing Room, 16<sup>th</sup> Floor, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. As discussed in Order No. 81102 in Case No. 9064,<sup>2</sup> the Commission will conduct a review of confidential and highly commercially sensitive bidder specific data during the process and at the hearing.
