## NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT HEARING AND COMMENT OPPORTUNITY

On December 30, 2021, Exelon Generating Company, LLC ("ExGen"), on behalf of itself, and Monitoring Analytics, LLC, acting in its capacity as the Independent Market Monitor for PJM ("IMM"), requested that, by February 14, 2022, the Commission approve a settlement agreement ("Settlement Agreement") that, together with revisions to ExGen's fuel cost policies that are being filed with PJM, resolves all but one of the proposals contained in the IMM's letter and confidential attached report submitted on March 11, 2021 and its June 15, 2021 and August 16, 2021 submittals in Case No. 9271.<sup>1</sup>

Accordingly, the Commission will hold a virtual hearing to consider the settlement agreement on February 1, 2022 at 10:00 AM. Parties that wish to comment on this matter may file comments by January 27, 2022.<sup>2</sup>
