NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

To: Service List for Case No. 9361 and Interested Persons

On December 22, 2016, pursuant to Merger Condition No. 18 in Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) Order No. 86990, Baltimore Gas and Electric Company, Potomac Electric Power Company and Delmarva Power & Light Company (collectively, the “Companies”) jointly filed a proposal for an Arrearage Management Program (“AMP”).¹ Merger Condition No. 18 required that the Companies, within 60 days of the closing of the merger, “initiate discussions with National Consumer Law Center and other interested stakeholders to consider in good faith the development of a mutually agreeable AMP for limited-income customers in arrears, which would include the provision of credits or matching payments for customers who make timely payments on their current bills,” and to submit any agreement regarding the adoption of an AMP to the Commission for its review and approval.

The Commission hereby issues a Notice of Request for Comments to stakeholders and interested parties regarding the Companies’ AMP Proposal. Written comments on the Proposal shall be filed by Friday, February 10, 2017. An original and seventeen copies of the comments, together with an electronic copy, shall be addressed to David J. Collins, Executive Secretary, Maryland Public Service Commission, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, 16th Floor, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. Five of the paper copies shall be three-holed punched. The Commission encourages the use of the Commission’s “e-Filing” system for submission of the
