On August 3, 2018, Delmarva Power & Light Company ("Company") filed with the Maryland Public Service Commission ("Commission") a Post-Construction Electric and Magnetic Field Monitoring Report ("Report") to meet the requirement of Condition No. 18 of Order No. 87156 ("Condition No. 18") issued in this matter. Condition No. 18 required the Company to submit the Report within three months of energizing the rebuilt 138 kV overhead transmission line between Church Substation in Queen Anne's County to the Steele Substation in Caroline County, Maryland ("Project"). According to the Company, the Project was energized on May 15, 2017. The Company, therefore, asks the Commission to grant a waiver of Condition No. 18 and accept the Company's compliance filing out of time.
