PUBLIC UTILITY LAW JUDGE'S NOTICE OF PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE

A prehearing conference in the above-entitled matter is hereby set for Thursday, June 25, 2015, at 2:00 p.m., in the Commission's 19th floor hearing room, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland. At the pre-hearing conference, any preliminary matters, including the consideration of any petitions to intervene and the establishment of a procedural schedule, will be discussed.

Great Bay Solar I, LLC is directed to provide notice to each member of the General Assembly representing any part of a county in which any portion of the generating facility is proposed to be constructed, and each member of the General Assembly representing any part of a county within one mile of the proposed location of the generating facility in accordance with Public Utilities Article § 7-207(c)(1)(iv-v). The Applicant shall submit certificates of service for all referenced notices.

Great Bay Solar I, LLC is also directed to cause a display advertisement to be published in a newspaper in general circulation throughout its service area at least one time before June 18, 2015, showing the time, date, place, and purpose (including the case number and case caption) of the conference set for Thursday, June 25, 2015. The notice shall also advise persons who seek to intervene in this proceeding that petitions to intervene should be filed with the Commission's Executive Secretary, David J. Collins, at 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202-6806, before the date of the conference.
