The Public Service Commission (“Commission”) has reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct a 6.0 MW Solar Photovoltaic Generating Facility in Queen Anne’s County, Maryland filed on June 16, 2015 by OneEnergy Sunfish Solar, LLC (“OneEnergy” or “Applicant”). OneEnergy is proposing to construct a 6.0 MW alternating current solar photovoltaic facility on a portion of a 129-acre parcel near the Town of Millington in Queen Anne’s County, Maryland. According to OneEnergy’s Application, the parcel is located one mile south of Millington and four miles north of Sudlersville. The Application also states that because of the nature of solar installations, environmental impacts from this project will be minimal and the long-term benefits significant.

After review of the Application, the Commission hereby docket the matter as Case No. 9383, sets the matter for hearing, and delegates the matter to the Public Utility Law Judge Division to conduct the proceedings.
