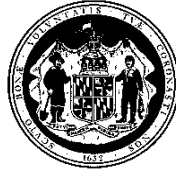

**GRANT OF MOTIONS FOR EXTENSION OF PAGE LIMITATION AND EXTENSION
OF TIME TO FILE MEMORANDUM ON APPEAL**

To: Service List – Case No. 9391

On October 17, 2016, the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (“WSSC”), filed with the Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) a Motion for Extension of Page Limitation for Memorandum on Appeal and a Motion for an Extension of Time to File its Memorandum on Appeal (collectively, “Motions”) in the above-referenced matter. Specifically, WSSC requests that the Commission alter the page limitation on Memoranda on Appeal to 25 pages so that WSSC and all parties who filed appeals can fully and comprehensively brief the issues. In addition, WSSC seeks an extension of two weeks for all parties to file their respective Memoranda given the magnitude and importance of the issue in this proceeding. WSSC indicates in its Motions that no party opposes its requests.¹

¹ See ML# 201197. WSSC notes that it attempted to contact Counsel for the Office of People’s Counsel (“OPC”) in this proceeding prior to filing its Motions, but Counsel is out of the office until Tuesday, October 18, 2016 and therefore cannot represent the position of OPC on these matters.

The Commission has considered WSSC's Motions for an extension of the page limitation on the parties Memoranda on Appeal and an extension of time for the parties to file such Memoranda. The Commission finds good cause to extend the page limit up to 25 pages on all Parties' Memoranda on Appeal. The Commission directs that the Memoranda and 17 copies should be submitted double-sided and in a 12-point or greater font size. In addition, the Commission hereby grants WSSC's Motion for a two week extension of time for parties to file their respective Memoranda on Appeal to November 4, 2016, as applicable, in this proceeding.
