**GRANT OF REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF PAGE LIMITATION ON INITIAL AND
REPLY MEMORANDA ON APPEAL**

To: Service List – Case No. 9424

On January 13, 2016, the Delmarva Power & Light Company (“Delmarva” or “Company”) filed with the Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) an Unopposed Request to Enlarge Page Limits for the Memorandum on Appeal (“Request”) in the above-referenced matter.¹ Specifically, Delmarva requests that the Commission extend the page limitation on Memoranda on Appeal and Reply Memoranda to 20 pages so that all parties can fully and comprehensively brief the issues. Delmarva’s Request indicates that the Company has contacted all parties in this proceeding and that none of the parties object to increasing the page limitation to 20 pages.

The Commission has considered Delmarva’s Request. The Commission finds good cause to extend the page limit up to 20 pages on all Parties’ Memoranda on Appeal and Reply
