The Public Service Commission (“Commission”) has reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct a 45.9 MW Solar Photovoltaic Generating Facility in the City of Cambridge, Maryland filed on December 20, 2016 by Egypt Road Solar, LLC (“Egypt Road Solar” or “Applicant”). Egypt Road Solar is proposing to construct a 45.9 MW alternating current solar photovoltaic facility on three parcels totaling approximately 320 acres across two properties in the City of Cambridge located in Dorchester County, Maryland. According to Egypt Road Solar’s Application, the project will have minimal environmental impacts and yield significant economic benefits to the State.

After review of the Application, the Commission hereby docket the matter as Case No. 9434, sets the matter for hearing, and delegates the matter to the Public Utility Law Judge Division to conduct the proceedings.
