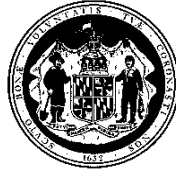

Dear Mr. Chason:

The Public Service Commission ("Commission") has reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct a 56.7 MW Solar Photovoltaic Generating Facility in Queen Anne's County, Maryland filed on December 21, 2016 by Jones Farm Lane Solar, LLC ("Jones Farm" or "Applicant"). Jones Farm is proposing to construct a 56.7 MW alternating current solar photovoltaic facility on three parcels totaling approximately 337 acres of property located at 148 Jones Farm Lane in an unincorporated area of Queen Anne's County, Maryland. According to Jones Farm's Application, the project will have minimal environmental impacts and yield significant economic benefits to the State.

After review of the Application, the Commission hereby docket the matter as Case No. 9436, sets the matter for hearing, and delegates the matter to the Public Utility Law Judge Division to conduct the proceedings.
