Pepco is hereby directed to publish, once in each of the two (2) successive weeks prior to each hearing date, notice of the public hearing and the opportunity for public comment by a display advertisement in newspapers of general circulation in each county within the Pepco service territory. In the display advertisement, Pepco is directed to publish the case caption and case number in addition to the date, time, place and purpose of the hearing. Proof of publication shall be filed with the Commission on or before the date of the hearings. Additionally, Pepco shall place on its home page a notice of the hearings, including the purpose of the hearings, in a manner that a customer need not click on a link to determine the date, time, location and purpose of the hearings.

Furthermore, Pepco is directed to issue either a bill message or bill insert to its Maryland customers in their respective billing cycle that runs closest and prior to the hearing dates, announcing the date, time, place, and purpose of the hearing. Finally, Pepco is directed to utilize social media or other means of communication at its disposal to further notify its customers of the public hearings, as appropriate.
