**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO OBJECT**

On August 9, 2017, the Potomac Electric Power Company (“Pepco”) filed a Motion for Leave to File Additional Supplemental Testimony Regarding Recovery of RM54 Program Development Costs in Response to the Commission’s Letter Order issued August 1, 2017 and Request for Expedited Treatment (“Motion”).<sup>1</sup> Specifically, Pepco seeks leave to file limited supplemental testimony (attached to its Motion) to comply with a Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) request that Pepco address the appropriateness of allowing Pepco to recover programming costs it incurred to comply with certain COMAR revisions the Commission adopted in Rule Making 54 (“RM54”). Pepco further requests that the Commission issue an order on or before August 21, 2017 so that parties have an opportunity to respond to the Motion and, if granted, allow parties to respond to this supplemental testimony in their Surrebuttal Testimony which is due August 24, 2017.

The Commission hereby requests that any objections to Pepco’s Motion shall be filed by Noon, August 21, 2017. An original and 17 copies and an electronic copy<sup>2</sup> of any objection shall be submitted to David J. Collins, Executive Secretary, Maryland Public Service Commission, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, 16<sup>th</sup> Floor, Baltimore, Maryland 21202.
