The Public Service Commission ("Commission") has reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct a 2.5 MW Solar Photovoltaic Generating Facility in Prince George's County, Maryland filed on April 11, 2017 by Sol Phoenix Solar, LLC ("Sol Phoenix Solar" or "Applicant"). Sol Phoenix Solar is proposing to construct a 2.5 MW solar generating facility on a 12-acre portion of contiguous leased properties in Prince George's County, Maryland. The Application indicates that this project will provide significant economic and environmental benefits and little negative impacts.
