The Public Service Commission (“Commission”) has reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct a 27.5 MW Solar Photovoltaic Generating Facility in Charles County, Maryland filed on September 26, 2017 by MD Solar 2, LLC (“MD Solar 2” or “Applicant”). MD Solar 2 is proposing to construct a 27.5 MW solar generating facility on 193 acres and associated interconnection facilities in Charles County, Maryland. The Application indicates that this project (Ripley Road Solar Project) will have minimal environmental impact and will provide significant economic benefits to the State.

After review of the Application, the Commission hereby docket the matter as Case No. 9463, sets the matter for hearing, and delegates the matter to the Public Utility Law Judge Division to conduct the proceedings.
