The Maryland Public Service Commission ("Commission") has reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct a 2.25 MW Solar Photovoltaic Generating Facility in Prince George's County, Maryland filed on November 9, 2017 by TPE Maryland Solar Land Holdings, LLC ("Applicant"). The Applicant is proposing to construct a 2.25 MW solar generating facility on a 12-acre portion of a land parcel located along South Osborne Road in Prince George's County, Maryland. The Application indicates that this project will have significant economic and environmental benefits and little negative impacts.
