The Maryland Public Service Commission ("Commission") has reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct a 10 MW Solar Photovoltaic Generating Facility in Prince George's County, Maryland filed on December 21, 2017 by Energy Ventures IPP, LLC ("Applicant"). The Applicant is proposing to construct a 10 MW solar generating facility on an approximate 56.91-acre portion of contiguous leased properties within the general boundary limits of Mattawoman Drive and Timothy Drive in Prince George's County, Maryland.
