NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

To: All Parties of Record and Interested Persons

On January 22, 2019, the Department of Natural Resources, Power Plant Research Program (“PPRP”), filed with the Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) a letter requesting further modification to the procedural schedule in the above-styled proceeding.¹ In its letter, PPRP requested that the time between the filing of the rebuttal testimony (March 18, 2019) and surrebuttal testimony (April 1, 2019) in the matter be extended for 45 days. Pursuant to the request, the surrebuttal testimony would be due on May 2, 2019.

The evidentiary hearing in the matter is currently scheduled to begin on April 8, 2019, with a completion date on or before April 25, 2019. If the Commission were to grant PPRP’s request, the Commission would need to reschedule the evidentiary hearings as well as the hearings for public comment.

The Commission provides the opportunity for the parties in the matter to comment on PPRP’s request. Any comments to PPRP’s request shall be filed by February 4, 2019. An original and 17 paper copies, and one electronic copy,² of the comments shall be submitted to Terry J. Romine, Executive Secretary, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, 16th Floor, Baltimore, MD 20201, and reference “Case No. 9471.” Five of the paper copies shall be three-hole punched.
