## **NOTICE OF PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE**

On December 27, 2017, Transource Maryland, LLC ("Applicant") filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for authority to construct two new 230 kilovolt transmission lines associated with the Independence Energy Connection Project in portions of Harford and Washington Counties, Maryland.<sup>1</sup>

A pre-hearing conference in the above-entitled matter is hereby set for February 16, 2018, in the Commission's 16th floor hearing room, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland, beginning at 1:00 p.m. The purpose of the pre-hearing conference is to set a procedural schedule for this proceeding, consider any petitions to intervene that have been filed, and consider any other preliminary matters requested by the parties.

Petitions to intervene in the matter must be filed with the Commission's Executive Secretary, David J. Collins, 6 St. Paul Street, 16th Floor, Baltimore, Maryland 21202, by Wednesday, February 7, 2018, and must reference **Case No. 9471**. Pursuant to the Commission's policy, an original and 17 hard copies and an electronic copy<sup>2</sup> of the Petition must be submitted.

The Applicant is directed to cause a display advertisement to be published in a newspaper in general circulation within Harford and Washington Counties at least twice, in successive weeks, prior to February 16, 2018, to include the case caption, case number, the time, date, place, and purpose of the pre-hearing conference. The notice shall also advise persons who seek to intervene in this proceeding that petitions to intervene shall be filed with the Commission's Executive Secretary by close of business, February 7, 2018.

Additionally, the Applicant is encouraged to use any social media or other communication methods to advise residents/businesses of Harford and Washington Counties of the date, time, location, and purpose of the pre-hearing conference as well as the date by which petitions to intervene must be submitted. The Applicant is directed to file a certificate of publication and postings with the Commission on or before the date of the pre-hearing conference.

Further, if the Applicant has not done so at the time of the filing of its application with the Commission, the Applicant is directed to serve notice and a copy of the application to the following prior to the pre-hearing conference:
