The Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) has reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct a 202 MW Solar Photovoltaic Generating Facility in Caroline County, Maryland filed on January 23, 2018 by Cherrywood Solar I, LLC (“Applicant”). The Applicant is proposing to construct a 202 MW solar generating facility occupying portions of sixteen parcels and approximately four additional parcels with easements to accommodate the buried connector lines in Caroline County, Maryland. The Application indicates that this project will have significant economic benefits with minimal environmental impacts.

After review of the Application, the Commission hereby docketed the matter as Case No. 9477, sets the matter for hearing, and delegates the matter to the Public Utility Law Judge Division to conduct the proceedings.
