NOTICE OF HEARING AND COMMENT DUE DATES

On April 19, 2019, Baltimore Gas and Electric Company, Potomac Electric Power Company, and Delmarva Power & Light Company (“Joint Utilities”) filed with the Commission a Post-Order Compliance Filing Regarding Implementation of Approved Electric Vehicle Charging Program Offerings (“Filing”).¹ Included in the Filing are proposed tariffs for each of the Joint Utilities. In the Filing, the Joint Utilities requested that the Commission accept the proposed tariffs on or before June 30, 2019, so that the tariffs have an effective date of July 1, 2019, which is the date the Joint Utilities plan to begin offering their associated programs to the public.

The Commission has scheduled the Filing, including the proposed tariffs, for consideration at its June 19, 2019 Administrative Meeting. The matter will be the last item considered. Although the Filing will be considered at the Administrative Meeting, the Commission hereby sets a procedural schedule for filing of comments, rather than allowing parties or interested parties to file comments generally permitted for Administrative Meeting items. Comments that are not filed

pursuant to the procedural schedule as set forth herein will not be considered by the Commission for this matter.

Interested persons shall file comments on the Filing, including the proposed tariffs, by May 31, 2019. Reply comments shall be filed by June 10, 2019. An original and 17 paper copies, and one electronic copy,² of the comments or reply comments shall be submitted to Terry J. Romine, Executive Secretary. Maryland Public Service Commission, 6 St. Paul Street, 16th Floor, Baltimore, Maryland 21202 and shall reference “Case No. 9478.” Five of the paper copies shall be three-hole punched.
