NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO FILE FINAL COMMENTS

On September 6 and 7, 2018, the Maryland Public Service Commission ("Commission") held a legislative-style hearing to gather additional information to help the Commission determine what action to take on the Public Conference 44 ("PC44") Electric Vehicle ("EV") Work Group Leader's Petition for Implementation of a Statewide Electric Vehicle Portfolio. The Commission heard from many participants in the PC44 EV Work Group during the two-day hearing.
