The Public Service Commission (“Commission”) has reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Construct a 9.9 MW Solar Photovoltaic Generating Facility in the Town of Union Bridge and Carroll County, Maryland (“CPCN”) (“Application”) filed by Citizens UB Solar LLC (“Applicant”). According to the Application, the facility is proposed to be constructed in Union Bridge along Green Valley Road immediately adjacent to the Carroll Substation. Currently, the proposed facility site is used for farm operations and is across the road from Lehigh Cement and several blocks from downtown Union Bridge.

After review of the Application, the Commission hereby docket the matter as Case No. 9483, sets the matter for hearing, and delegates the matter to the Public Utility Law Judge Division to conduct the proceedings.
