NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF JANUARY 17, 2019 EVENING HEARING

To: Service List for Case No. 9490 and Interested Persons

The Maryland Public Service Commission has canceled the evening hearing for public comments on The Potomac Edison Company’s application for an increase in retail rates, which was scheduled to be conducted at 6:30 p.m. at Winchester Hall in Frederick, Maryland on January 17, 2019.

The Baltimore/Washington National Weather Service issued a Winter Weather Advisory from 4:00 p.m., January 17, 2019, to 4:00 a.m., January 18, 2019, and advised of potential hazardous travel conditions during the evening commute. The Commission is cancelling the hearing so that ratepayers may avoid traveling during the evening.
