NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND

On December 10, 2018, The Potomac Edison Company (“Company”) filed with the Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) a Motion to Enforce the Procedural Schedule and Strike Portion of the Revised Direct Testimony of OPC Witnesses Pavlovic and Effron (“Motion”). In the Motion, the Company alleges that the revised direct testimony of OPC witnesses Pavlovic and Effron “contains new substantive positions that could, and should, have been included in their original direct testimony.” The Company requests that the Commission strike the substantive revisions. Additionally, the Company asks for an expedited review in advance of its rebuttal testimony deadline.
