PE is hereby directed to publish, at least twice prior to each of the hearing dates, notice of the public hearing and the opportunity for public comment by a display advertisement in newspapers of general circulation in each county or municipality within the PE service territory. In the display advertisement, PE is directed to publish the case caption and case number in addition to the date, time, place, and purpose of the hearings. Proof of publication shall be filed with the Commission on or before the dates of hearing. Additionally, PE shall place on its home page a notice of the hearings, including the purpose of the hearings, in a manner that a customer need not click on a link to determine the date, time, location, and purpose of the hearings.

Furthermore, PE is directed to issue either a bill message or bill insert to its Maryland customers in their respective billing cycle that runs closest and prior to the hearing dates, announcing the date, time, place, and purpose of the hearing. Finally, PE is directed to utilize email, its routinely used social media platforms, or other means of communication at its disposal to further notify its customers of the hearings, as appropriate.
