The Maryland Public Service Commission hereby gives notice that it will conduct a legislative-style hearing on May 7, 2020, beginning at 10:00 a.m. via virtual meeting, to consider the EmPOWER Maryland Semi-Annual Reports for the period from July 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019 ("Reports")<sup>1</sup> filed by Baltimore Gas and Electric Company ("BGE"),<sup>2</sup> The Potomac Edison Company,<sup>3</sup> Southern Maryland Electric Cooperative, Inc.,<sup>4</sup> Potomac Electric Power Company,<sup>5</sup> and Delmarva Power & Light Company<sup>6</sup> (collectively, "the

Joint Utilities"), Washington Gas Light Company,<sup>7</sup> and the Department of Housing and Community Development with respect to its Limited Income Programs.<sup>8</sup>

The Commission also will consider the Electric and Natural Gas Coordination Work Group report on the Coordinated Residential New Construction Program to be filed on or before April 15, 2020.<sup>9</sup>
