The Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) hereby gives notice that it will conduct a legislative-style hearing on May 2, 2019, beginning at 10:00 a.m. in the Frank O. Heinz Hearing Room, 16th Floor, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland, to consider the EmPOWER Maryland Semi-Annual Reports for the period from July 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018 (“Reports”) ¹ filed by Baltimore Gas and Electric Company,² The Potomac Edison Company,³ Southern Maryland Electric Cooperative, Inc.,⁴ Potomac Electric Power Company,⁵ and Delmarva Power & Light Company⁶ (collectively, “the

Joint Utilities”), Washington Gas Light Company,⁷ and the Department of Housing and Community Development with respect to its Limited Income Programs.⁸

Additionally, the Midstream Program Work Group filed a “Status Report of the Midstream Program Implementation” (“Status Report”).⁹ The Joint Utilities submitted an informational filing to modify incentive structures for Commercial and Industrial Custom Programs (“Informational Filing”).¹⁰

Written comments on the EmPOWER Reports, the Status Report, and the Informational Filing shall be filed by Monday, April 15, 2019. An original and 17 paper copies, and one electronic copy, of the comments shall be submitted to Terry J.
