The Public Service Commission (“Commission”) has reviewed the Application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“CPCN”) for the Bush River Crossing Project filed on April 17, 2020 by Baltimore Gas and Electric Company (“BGE” or “Company”) (“Application or “Project”). The Company is proposing to replace a 1.3 mile portion of an existing 115kV transmission line (Circuits 110620/110621) that runs from Edgewood to Perryman across the Bush River, in Harford County, Maryland.

After review of the Application, the Commission hereby docket the matter as Case No. 9642, sets the matter for hearing, and delegates the matter to the Public Utility Law Judge Division to conduct the proceedings.
