**NOTICE OF Q1/Q2 2021 EMPOWER MARYLAND
SEMI-ANNUAL HEARING AND COMMENT PERIOD**

The Commission hereby gives notice that it will conduct a legislative-style hearing on November 16, 2021, beginning at 10:00 a.m., to consider the Q1/Q2 2021 EmPOWER Maryland semi-annual reports of The Potomac Edison Company,¹ Baltimore Gas and Electric Company,² Delmarva Power & Light Company,³ Potomac Electric Power Company,⁴ Southern Maryland Electric Cooperative, Inc.,⁵ and Washington Gas Light Company⁶ (“WGL”) (collectively, the “Joint Utilities”), and the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (“DHCD”).⁷

At the November 16, 2021 hearing, the Commission also will consider the Evaluation, Measurement, and Verification (“EM&V”) Work Group reports⁸ and Cost

Recovery Work Group reports⁹ as directed in Order No. 89679, the 2020 Evaluation, Verification, and Cost Effectiveness reports for the electric utilities, WGL, and DHCD, and the Combined Heat and Power Work Group report,¹⁰ which are to be filed by October 15, 2021.

Written comments on the semi-annual reports shall be filed by October 15, 2021.¹¹ The location and nature of the hearing will be determined at a future date.
