**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF VIRTUAL EVIDENTIARY HEARINGS
AND EXHIBIT DEADLINE**

On January 12, 2021, the Commission issued a Revised Procedural Schedule, in which the Commission scheduled evidentiary hearings regarding Potomac Electric Power Company's Application for an Electric Multi-Year Plan from April 26 through 30, 2021.¹ The Commission hereby gives Notice that the hearings will be virtual.²

Accordingly, in order to accommodate the virtual nature of the evidentiary hearings, all parties to this case are required to prepare and email an exhibit list along with pre-marked copies of any exhibits that they may introduce at the evidentiary hearing to Katherine Fueston by 10 AM on Friday, April 23, 2021, and copy the other parties.³ Please direct any questions about this process to Katherine Fueston at katherine.fueston@maryland.gov.

All parties to the case are also required to provide Katherine Fueston with a list⁴ of Counsel and associated witnesses they plan to introduce or sponsor during the hearings, as well as which witnesses from opposing parties each Counsel plans to cross-examine by 10 AM on Friday, April 23, 2021.

² The Commission will conduct the evidentiary hearing via virtual meeting on Webex.

³ Copies of exhibits that have been pre-filed in Case No. 9655 do not need to be e-mailed prior to the evidentiary hearing, but must be included on the party's exhibit list itself. Parties may supplement their exhibit lists after the hearing starts on Monday, April 26, 2021. Continuing its practices from other virtual evidentiary hearings, absent a reason to exclude an unanticipated exhibit, the Commission will be flexible and allow its introduction. The Commission's general expectation is that the parties anticipate the exhibits that they will file to the best of their ability, and it appreciates the good faith efforts the parties have pledged to make their exhibit lists as complete as possible.

⁴ The list from each party shall include the e-mail addresses for each Counsel and sponsored witness.

For purposes of these evidentiary hearings, Counsel and witnesses are deemed “participants.” All other individuals may watch the livestream of the hearings on the Commission’s YouTube channel.⁵ Any questions about the hearings should also be directed to Ms. Fueston.

Additionally, the Commission’s Technical Staff will be contacting the parties to establish a schedule of witnesses appearing for each hearing day.

Finally, the evidentiary hearing on Wednesday, April 28, 2021 will begin approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the Administrative Meeting, which begins at 10 a.m. that day.
