The Maryland Public Service Commission (“Commission”) hereby gives notice that it will conduct hearings on May 23, 2017 beginning at 10:00 a.m., May 24, 2017 beginning at 1:00 p.m., and May 25, 2017 beginning at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission’s 16th Floor Hearing Room, William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202 to consider the EmPOWER Maryland Semi-Annual Reports for the period from July 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016 (“Reports”) filed by Baltimore Gas and Electric Company (Case No. 9154), The Potomac Edison Company d/b/a Allegheny Power (Case No. 9153), Southern Maryland Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Case No. 9157), Potomac Electric Power Company (Case No. 9155), Delmarva Power & Light Company (Case No. 9156), Washington Gas Light Company (Case No. 9362), and the Department of Housing and Community Development with respect to its Limited Income Energy Efficiency and Multifamily Energy Efficiency and Housing Affordability Programs.¹ In addition, on the last day of the hearings (May 25), pursuant to Order No. 88007, the Commission will host a public technical conference for stakeholders and other interested parties to discuss the development of future energy efficiency programs in preparation for the 2018 – 2020 EmPOWER Maryland Program Cycle.
