NOTICE OF NEW ROOM LOCATION

FOR HEARING FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON CHANGES IN TURBINE SELECTION

On December 27, 2019, the Maryland Public Service Commission issued an Notice of Hearing for Public Comment on Changes in Turbine Selection¹ in connection with the public correspondence filed by Skipjack Offshore Energy, LLC ("Skipjack") and U.S. Wind, Inc. ("U.S. Wind") (together, "Applicants") announcing changes in the turbine selection size originally anticipated for use in their respective offshore wind projects.² Since that time, the room location

within the Ocean City Convention Center has been **changed from Rooms 215-217 to the Bayfront Ballroom**. The Bayfront Ballroom is also located on the second floor of the Convention Center.
