SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF VIRTUAL EVIDENTIARY HEARINGS

On June 12, 2020, the Maryland Public Service Commission issued Order No. 89565, in which the Commission scheduled evidentiary hearings regarding the Application of Baltimore Gas and Electric Company for an Electric and Gas Multi-Year Plan from October 13 through October 21, 2020.¹ The Commission hereby gives Notice that the hearings will be virtual.²

Accordingly, in order to accommodate the virtual nature of the evidentiary hearings, all parties to this case are required to prepare and email an exhibit list along with pre-marked copies of any exhibits that they may introduce at the evidentiary hearing to Katherine Fueston by 12 noon on Wednesday, October 7, 2020, and copy the other parties.³ Please direct any questions about this process to Katherine Fueston at katherine.fueston@maryland.gov.

All parties to the case are also required to provide Katherine Fueston with a list⁴ of Counsel and associated witnesses they plan to introduce or sponsor during the hearings, as well as which witnesses from opposing parties each Counsel plans to cross-examine by noon on Wednesday, October 7, 2020.⁵ For purposes of these evidentiary hearings, Counsel and witnesses are deemed “participants.” All other individuals may watch the livestream of the
