Public Comment Hearing Jan. 11 for Delmarva Rate Case

(BALTIMORE, MD) – The Maryland Public Service Commission will hold a virtual public comment hearing on the \$27 million electricity rate increase requested by Delmarva Power & Light Company. Utility customers and other interested parties are welcome to take part in the hearing which is scheduled for **Tuesday, January 11, 2022 at 7 p.m.** Chief Public Utility Law Judge Ryan C. McLean will preside. The hearing will begin with a presentation by Delmarva.

Delmarva provides electric distribution services to 209,000 Maryland customers in 10 Eastern Shore counties. The company says it needs the additional revenue to cover expenses to maintain and improve customer service and system reliability.

The hearing will be held on the Webex platform and participants will receive an email with the link to join in.
