Notice of Rulemaking (RM81), Rulemaking Session, and Request for Comments

On September 28, 2023, the Leader of the PC44 Interconnection Work Group ("Work Group") submitted a Phase V Final Report and Petition for Rulemaking — Revisions to Subtitle 50 of Title 20, Code of Maryland Regulations.
