REQUEST FOR COMMENTS

From December 22, 2021 through January 18, 2022, Baltimore Gas and Electric Company,¹ the Easton Utilities Commission,² Chesapeake Utilities Corporation (for Chesapeake Utilities, Sandpiper Energy, Inc. and Chesapeake Elkton Gas),³ Columbia Gas of Maryland, Inc.,⁴ and Washington Gas Light Company⁵ filed their respective gas service regulator relocation plans in compliance with Section 7-313(b)(3) of the Public Utilities Article, *Annotated Code of Maryland*,⁶ which provides that "[o]n or before January 1, 2022, a gas company shall file a plan with the Commission to relocate any gas service regulator that provides service to a multifamily residential structure."
