NOTICE: EXTENSION OF DEADLINE TO FILE THE NET ENERGY METERING REPORT

On August 20, 2020, the Staff of the Maryland Public Service Commission ("Staff") requested an extension, from September 1, 2020 to October 1, 2020, for filing the Net Energy Metering Report required under Public Utilities Article ("PUA"), *Annotated Code of Maryland*, § 7-306(h). Staff states that, despite having issued its data request on July 6, 2020, which is substantially the same date as in previous years, Staff does not have data responses from all the utilities that must be covered by the Report. Staff believes that an extended deadline to October 1, 2020 should be sufficient for the utilities to complete their data requests and for Staff to complete its draft report for the Commission's review.

The Chairman, on behalf of the Commission, hereby extends the deadline to file the Net Energy Metering Report required under PUA § 7-306(h) from September 1, 2020 to October 1, 2020.

This extension is pursuant to the Proclamation of Governor Lawrence J. Hogan, Jr. (the "Governor") dated March 5, 2020 proclaiming a state of emergency and a catastrophic health emergency related to COVID-19, as it may be amended or renewed from time to time, and the Order of the Governor dated March 12, 2020 entitled "Extending Certain Licenses, Permits, Registrations, and Other Governmental Authorizations, and Authorizing Suspension of Legal Time Requirements," as it may be amended from time to time, after finding that the action(s) described herein will not endanger the public health, welfare, or safety.
