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**Notice of Further Rulemaking Session (RM76)**

On February 14, 2024, the Leader of the Cybersecurity Reporting Workgroup (CSRWG) filed with the Commission a Petition for Rulemaking to adopt proposed changes to COMAR 20.06.<sup>1</sup>
