NOTICE OF HEARING

On March 1 and 12, 2024, various companies filed their semi-annual EV Pilot Program Progress Reports and Final EV Program Reports.¹ On March 22, 2024, the EV Workgroup Leader requested procedural guidance as to whether the Commission wanted to 1) focus upcoming party comments and hearing on the evaluation of Phase I utility programs, including the success of the individual programs and issues of broader program design, like cost allocation and cost recovery, and on the appropriate role for the utilities within the EV charging sector moving forward; or 2) consider feedback on Phase I evaluations as well as Phase II proposals.
