Notice of Hearing

A Status Conference regarding unresolved issues related to Potomac Electric Power Company's (Pepco) Tariff Schedules SSL-OH and SSL-OH-LED was held on May 3, 2023, for discussion of the unresolved issues and to set a procedural schedule. The parties agreed that additional time was needed to finalize both the list of unresolved issues and the procedural schedule.

On May 15, 2023, Pepco and Chevy Chase Village, Village of North Chevy Chase, Chevy Chase Section Three, the City of Gaithersburg, and Washington Grove filed a final joint issues list pertaining to the outstanding issues related to the model streetlight license agreement and the model streetlight purchase agreement.¹ Additionally, the procedural schedule is confirmed as follows:

- (a) Parties shall file initial briefs by June 2, 2023;
- (b) Parties shall file reply briefs filed by June 20, 2023; and
- (c) A hearing for oral presentations will be held on July 13, 2023 at 10:00 AM, in the Frank O. Heintz Hearing Room, on the 16th Floor of the William Donald Schaefer Tower, 6 St. Paul Street, Baltimore, Maryland.

The Commission also hereby initiates a new docket, Case No. 9703, to permit the Commission to consider additional filings on this matter.
