NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT HEARINGS

On May 16, 2023, Potomac Electric Power Company (“Pepco”) submitted to the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) an Application for an Electric Multi-Year Plan (“Application”).¹ Pepco also filed revised tariffs, supporting testimony, exhibits, supplemental information, and the Multi-Year Plan (“MYP”) filing requirements as adopted by the Commission in Order No. 90729.

A prehearing scheduling conference was held on August 2, 2023. On August 7, 2023, the Commission adopted a procedural schedule for the matter², except for the schedule for evening public hearings that will be held in Pepco’s service territory.

Notice is hereby given that two hearings for the purpose of soliciting comments from the public will be held simultaneously in-person and virtually on **Tuesday, March 5, 2024 at 6:30 p.m. at Prince George’s Community College, Largo Campus, Kent Hall Administration Building, 301 Largo Road, Largo, MD 20774** and on **Tuesday, March 26, 2024 at 6:30 p.m.**

Comments submitted electronically must be submitted through the Commission's Public Comment Dropbox, which can be accessed through the Commission's website at www.psc.state.md.us. Commenters utilizing the Public Comment Dropbox for the first-time are required to complete a one-time registration. All comments must include a reference to Case No. 9702. Pepco is hereby directed to publish a notice of the public comment hearings, including the caption, case number, the time, date, access information for the hearing, and the deadline for written comments for the hearings, at least two times by March 4, 2024 and March 25, 2024, respectively, as a display advertisement in newspapers in general circulation throughout Pepco's service area.

Pepco is also directed to place on its homepage a notice of the public hearing in a manner that a customer need not click the link to determine the date, time, and purpose of the public

hearing or the date by which public comments must be filed. Further, Pepco is directed to employ any routinely used social media platforms, such as Twitter or Facebook, and any other means of communication at its disposal to further notify its customers of the public hearing and the date by which public comments must be filed.
