Notice Initiating Rulemaking (RM82) and Notice of Rulemaking Session

On December 19, 2023, the Leaders of the PC57 Work Group (Work Group) filed a summary report with the Commission requesting the Commission initiate a rulemaking to adopt the proposed regulations to implement the directives in Order No. 90682. Accordingly, the Commission hereby initiates an Administrative Docket, RM82, to consider revisions to Code of Maryland Regulation (COMAR) 20.40, 20.31, and 20.85.
