Issue Date: October 12, 2016

Upon consideration of the Petition to Intervene filed on October 7, 2016 by Yellow Transportation, Checker Cab, and ExecuCar (“Yellow”), and the Opposition thereto filed on October 11, 2016 by Rasier, LLC (“Rasier”), the Commission finds that Yellow’s extensive experience with, and knowledge of, the criminal background check through the State’s Criminal Justice Information System Central Repository (“CJIS”) required under Section 10-104(b) Public Utilities Article, *Annotated Code of Maryland* is relevant to the issues before the Commission, and finds that parties to this proceeding do not adequately represent Yellow’s interests.¹ Therefore, in accordance with Section § 3-106(b) of the Public Utilities Article, *Annotated Code of Maryland*, Yellow’s Petition to Intervene shall be granted.

IT IS, THEREFORE, on this 12th day of October in the year Two Thousand

¹ As set forth in its Petition to Intervene, Yellow Transportation is Baltimore’s oldest and largest taxicab company, serving approximately 5 million people annually with a fleet of over 600 vehicles. Its taxi service operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year in Baltimore City (Yellow, Checker and Sun Cabs) and Baltimore County (Jimmy’s Cab). ExecuCar provides airport shuttle services under the names Shuttle Express and Washington Shuttle. As such, Yellow has interests as a non-TNC entity providing transportation services; these interests are not adequately represented by the Commission’s Technical Staff Transportation Division or the Maryland Office of People’s Counsel.

Sixteen, by the Public Service Commission of Maryland,

ORDERED THAT: (1) Yellow Transportation, Checker Cab, and ExecuCar ("Yellow") is hereby granted permission to intervene in this proceeding as a Party;

(2) As a Party, Yellow shall abide by the procedural schedule adopted herein;
and

(3) Discovery for Yellow commences upon this grant of intervention. Yellow shall abide by the discovery procedure as outlined in Order No. 87784.
