**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND
GRANT OF REQUEST FOR REHEARING**

On January 15, 2020, The Potomac Edison Company (“PE”) filed a Request for Rehearing of Commission Order No. 89679 in the above-captioned proceeding (“Request”).¹ The Petitioners seek a rehearing of the Order on two items: (1) the Commission’s approval of PE’s Commercial and Industrial Prescriptive Program to correct incentives offered for appliance recycling measures, and (2) the finding that it must “use the incentive structures for Retrocommissioning Program HVAC Tune-Ups, Small Building Tune-Ups, Large Building Tune-Ups, Building Operations Training, and Monitoring-Based Commissioning as described in Table 107 of Staff’s comments.”² The Petitioners ask that the Commission approve incentives for the same measures offered under PE’s Commercial and Industrial Prescriptive Program that the Commission approved for the Residential Appliance Recycling Program, and to use the same incentive

structure for the Company's new Retrocommissioning Program as the Commission approved for the other EmPOWER Maryland utilities. PE also requests that the Commission grant expedited consideration to these requests to allow the Company to proceed with program implementation in as timely a manner as possible to help meet its EmPOWER goals.³

The Commission hereby grants PE's request for rehearing. Inasmuch as PE's requests may impact or bear relevance to other EmPOWER Maryland utilities, the Commission encourages other parties to raise any related issues. Accordingly, any comments on issues related to the Request shall be filed by February 9, 2021.
